Alwin has been based on the Mornington Peninsula since 2002 and enjoys living and working in the Mornington Peninsula community.

Mr Christopher Chang

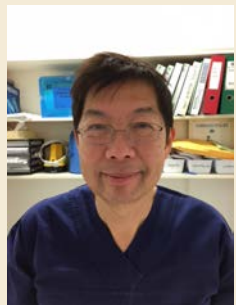
Urologists | **MBBS, FRACS**
